- demonstrated proficiency on the dispositions and the 4Cs (Critical Thinking, Communication, Creativity, Collaboration)
   evaluation
- signed acknowledgement of the Professional Code of Ethics for Kentucky Certified School Personnel and the character and fitness questionnaire.

**Program Requirements:** Maintain minimum GPA of 2.75. Any breach of the Professional Code of Ethics for Kentucky Certified School Personnel or failure to maintain the disposition expectations may result in dismissal.

#### Prior to admission to student teaching, candidates must

- · Meet with their advisor to complete a degree audit, application to graduate, and dispositions for teaching assessment.
- Candidates must complete the student teaching application and contact the Director of Student Teaching to schedule an admission interview.
- As a condition of admission to student teaching, all scores for the appropriate Praxis II exams must be on file.
