**Admission Criteria:** The following are required admission criteria to be admitted into the College of Education; following at least 30 credit hours in University Studies:

- minimum GPA of 2.75 (or 3.0 on the last 30 hours of credit completed)
- successful completion of the Praxis I® Pre-Professional Skills Tests (PPST®) (Mathematics -174; Reading – 176 and Writing – 174);
- demonstrated proficiency on the dispositions and the 4Cs (Critical Thinking, Communication, Creativity, Collaboration) evaluation
- signed acknowledgement of the Professional Code of Ethics for Kentucky Certified School Personnel and the character and fitness questionnaire.

**Program Requirements:** Maintain minimum GPA of 2.75. Any breach of the Professional Code of Ethics for Kentucky Certified School Personnel or failure to maintain the disposition expectations may result in dismissal.

**Prior to admission to student teaching, candidates must**

- Meet with their advisor to complete a degree audit, application to graduate, and dispositions for teaching assessment.
- Candidates must complete the student teaching application and contact the Director of Student Teaching to schedule an admission interview.
- As a condition of admission to student teaching, all scores for the appropriate Praxis II exams must be on file.
