† The requirement to take NURS 301 will be waived for students who have completed a CNA course within the last two years or who are listed on the Nurse Aide Registry. Nurse Aide Registry evidence and/or CNA course completion certificates must be submitted prior to Nursing program admission and will be verified by SON Faculty. Students for whom the NURS 301 requirement is waived must complete an elective approved by the School of Nursing. The elective must be a minimum of 3 credit hours and may be fulfilled by a transferred course.

Students must have completed all University Studies courses (49 hours) and additional required support courses (12 hours) prior to admission to nursing courses.
